SATURDAY, OCTOBER 30 –

For the Israel only travelers:

Depart from Seattle to **Munich** with Lufthansa Airlines **nonstop** flight # 489, leaving at 3:10pm.

For the Israel & Jordan travelers:

Depart from Seattle to **Frankfurt** with Lufthansa Airlines nonstop flight #491, leaving at 2:10pm.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 31 – GALILEE

(D)

For the Israel only travelers:

Arrive in **Munich** at 10:10am. Connect with Lufthansa Airlines **nonstop** flight #680 to Tel Aviv, leaving at 11:20am, arriving at 4:05pm.

For the Israel & Jordan travelers:

Arrive **Frankfurt** at 9:20am. Connect with Lufthansa Airlines nonstop flight #694 to Tel Aviv, leaving at 2:00pm and arriving at 7:15pm.

Upon arrival you will be met by a **Ya'lla Tours USA Israel** representative who will assist the group with the transfer to our hotel for overnight.

Our hotel, **MAGDALA**, opened at the end of 2019 and is located on the site of a 1st-century Jewish town, once the home of Mary Magdalene. The hotel is part of a complex of facilities built for visiting pilgrims and is 5 miles north of Tiberias on the shores of the Sea of Galilee. Facilities include a dining room and café, gift shop, concierge, outdoor pool, and an archaeological park. MONDAY, NOVEMBER 01 – GALILEE

(B,D)

Refreshed from a good night's sleep and a full buffet breakfast, we will drive through the fast-growing towns and farms of the **Plain of Sharon** to **Caesarea Maritima**, a large port city built by Herod the Great to honor Roman Caesar Augustus. Herod built a port in the bay and erected all the cultural institutions found in every great Greco-Roman city, including a theater, a hippodrome, and a luxurious bathhouse. In order to supply water to the city's ever-growing population, he built an aqueduct system stretching from the springs of Mt. Carmel to Caesarea. Part of this system is still visible today.

The Book of Acts refers repeatedly to Caesarea as the city Peter visited (Acts 10).

Continue north to **Mt. Carmel** to visit **Muhraka**, where Elijah challenged the prophets of Ba'al (I Kings 18:18).

Next, we head to **Megiddo** (I Kings 9:15), where archaeological digs have revealed 26 layers of civilization, including fortifications of **King Solomon** and a water tunnel of **King Ahab**. Megiddo provides a magnificent view of the fertile **Jezreel Valley**, the prophesied site of **Armageddon** at the crossroads of the ancient **Via Maris** "freeway."

Continue to our hotel on the shores of the Sea of Galilee for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 02 – GALILEE (B,L,D)

We take a memorable, **private** boat ride on the **Sea of Galilee** to visit the 2,000-year-old **Genosar Boat** ("the Jesus boat") discovered in 1986. Nearby, we visit the New Testament fishing village of **Magdala** (Matthew 27:56, 61).

Continue to **Tabga**, the traditional site of the multiplication of bread and fish (John 6:1), and then to **Capernaum**, with an ancient synagogue where Christ taught, and the disciples Peter and Andrew made their homes (John 6:24).

Then enjoy a **St. Peter's Fish lunch** by the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

Visit the **Church of the Primacy**, where Peter was first among the apostles to confess the divinity of Christ (Matthew 16:16; Mark 8:29; John 6:69).

Continue to the **Mt. of Beatitudes**, the traditional site where Jesus Christ delivered the Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5).

Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 03 – GALILEE (B,D)

Drive to the Upper Galilee and stop in **Tel Hatzor** and view the ancient excavations dating back to Joshua's conquest of Israel. (The book *The Source* by James A. Michener is based on Tel Hatzor.)

Next, we are off to the ruins of the prehistoric settlement at **Tel Dan**, once a thriving Canaanite community and the northern limit of the Promised Land. It was here that King Jeroboam set up a calf altar that brought disaster on Israel. Back on the bus, we continue north to **Caesarea Philippi** (Banias Spring), where Peter confessed to Jesus, "You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God" (Matthew 16:16). From this location, we can see **Mt. Hermon**, often covered with snow year-round.

Continue to visit **Nimrod Fortress**, one of the jewels of the Crusader fortresses in Israel.

Continue to **Mt. Bental** in the **Golan Heights**, a beautiful spot for panoramic views of the Upper Galilee, the Golan Heights, Mt. Hermon, and Syria.

Return to your hotel, where you will have the opportunity to renew your **baptism**.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 04 – JERUSALEM (B,L,D)

After an early breakfast drive to **Mt. Tabor** and take a taxi to the top for a visit to the Church of the Transfiguration. Enjoy an outstanding view of the Jezreel Valley where the battle of Deborah and the Midianites took place (Judges 5).

Continue to **Cana**, where Jesus performed "the first of his signs," turning water into wine at a wedding feast (John 2:1–11).

Then, onto **Nazareth** (Matthew 2:19-23), we will visit the **Annunciation Church** where tradition says the angel Gabriel appeared to Mary.

At **Nazareth Village**, enjoy a first-hand experience of the way of life in Galilee during the days of Jesus, *including a biblical-style lunch*.

Then visit **Mt. Precipice** (Luke 4:28-30), where Christ was taken "...in order to throw him off the cliff." Take in the view of the Jezreel Valley (Armageddon), Mt. Tabor (The Mt. of Transfiguration) and Mt. Gilboa (where Gideon chose his 300 brave men).

Drive to **Shiloh**, where the portable Tabernacle that Moses built in the wilderness was stationed from the time of the conquest until the city's apparent destruction by the Philistines in 1104 BC. "He abandoned the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent he had set up among men" (Psalms 78:60).

Then climb the Judean hills to the most beautiful city in the world, JERUSALEM, for **dinner** and overnight.

Our hotel, **GRAND COURT JERUSALEM**, is located near the historic Mandelbaum Gate and within easy walking distance of Jerusalem's Old City. All 442 guest rooms have air-conditioning, cable TV, phone with voice mail, mini-fridge, hair dryer, safe, and coffee maker. Amenities include free Wi-Fi, two restaurants, lobby lounge, concierge, seasonal outdoor swimming pool, children's pool and sundeck, health club, room service, and doctor on call.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 05 – JERUSALEM

(B,L,D)

Visit the **Israel Museum** to see an exhibition of the **Dead Sea Scrolls at the Shrine of the Book** and a scale model of Jerusalem as it was in Jesus' time.

Continue to **Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial**. *"As the Jewish people's living memorial to the Holocaust, Yad Vashem safeguards the memory of the past and imparts its meaning for future generations. For over half a century, Yad Vashem has been committed to four pillars of remembrance: Commemoration, Documentation, Research, and Education."* May we never forget the terrible price Israel paid to establish her country.

Drive 6 miles south of Jerusalem to **Bethlehem** (Micah 5:2 and Luke 2:1).

Enjoy a typical Arabic lunch.

Then visit the **Church of the Nativity**, the oldest church in the Holy Land still in use. Construction of this church began in 327AD over the traditional birthplace of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Since we know there will be big-time shoppers in our group, we have reserved time in the afternoon to look for souvenir treasures.

Then we continue through the Field of Boaz to **Shepherds' Field** (Luke 2), where we will revisit the Christmas story with the angels and shepherds of Bethlehem.

Return to Jerusalem for **dinner** and overnight.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 06 – JERUSALEM (B,D)

Drive east from Jerusalem to the lowest place on Earth, the Dead Sea.

See **Jericho** from a short distance and **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found in 1947.

Continue to **Masada**, a natural fortress with majestic ruins overlooking the Dead Sea. Take a cable car to the top of Masada for a tour. Jewish Zealots held the rock for several months in 73AD under siege by the 10th Roman legion. The Romans finally took the fortress by way of a massive attack ramp. The camps and other fortifications that encircle Masada constitute the most complete Roman siege works to have survived to the present day. Then drive to the **Dead Sea** for a float in the soothing, therapeutic water (bring towel, bathing suit and flip flops). Stop at the **Good Samaritan Inn** to revisit the famous parable in Luke 10 and view some ancient mosaics. Return to Jerusalem for **dinner** and overnight.

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 07 – JERUSALEM (B,D)

After an early breakfast, visit the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher**. In 325, Constantine's mother Helen first requisitioned the area for a church. The 4th-century church was largely destroyed by the Turks in 1009 and partially restored in 1048. The impressive stone decorations adorning the facade date from Crusader times. In its current form, the church preserves the Crusader structure and is shared by two major Christian denominations, the Greek Orthodox and the Roman Catholic. The church enshrines a tomb that some traditions hold to be the place of Jesus' burial and resurrection.

Then drive south to visit **Tel Azekah**, an Israelite military outpost from which we'll view the **Sorek Valley** and the **Elah Valley** (I Samuel 17:2-19), the site where David slew the giant Goliath, with only faith and a slingshot.

Visit the archaeological site **Tel Lachish**.

Return to Jerusalem for some free time to wander on your own.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 08 – JERUSALEM (B,D)

Drive to **Bethphage** on the eastern slopes of Mt. of Olives to see a first-century tomb.

Visit the **Chapel of the Ascension** (Acts 1:6-11) and the **Church of Pater Noster** on the hill where Jesus was inspired with the Lord's Prayer. The walls of the church are covered with prayers written in over 80 languages (Matthew 6:9-13).

Drive to the top of **Mt. of Olives** (Acts 1:8) for a magnificent view of the **Old City**.

Then we take the "Palm Sunday Walk" to the **Dominus Flevit Church** ("the Lord weeps," Luke 19:41-44). During construction in 1955, archaeologists uncovered artifacts dating back to the Canaanite period as well as tombs from both the Second Temple and Byzantine eras. Also unearthed were the remains of a lovely Byzantine shrine with an elaborate mosaic floor that was incorporated into the church.

Continue walking down to the **Garden of Gethsemane** (Matthew 26:36). Some of the oldest olive trees in the world are here. Visit the **Church of All Nations**, which contains the stone where Jesus prayed on the night of his betrayal, according to tradition. We will have time for singing, reflection, and prayer in a quiet area of the Garden of Gethsemane.

Stop at the **St. Stephen's Basilica** for teaching of Pastor Mark.

Enter the Old City through **Stephen's Gate (Lions' Gate)** and the **Christian Quarter**. Here is the **Pool of Bethesda** (John 5:1), where Jesus healed the lame man, and **St. Anne's Church**, an outstanding example of Crusader architecture with amazing acoustics.

Walk along to the **Church of the Flagellation**, the site where Jesus was given the cross to carry.
Return to the hotel for **dinner** and overnight.

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 09 – JERUSALEM (B,D)

Start the morning with a visit to **Caiaphas Palace** (Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, John 18:12) and see the cistern where Jesus was held before he was taken to Pilate and the Roman Period steps, he walked from the Kidron Valley.

Next, we will visit the **City of David** and see excavations which reveal the period of King David. If weather permits, we will walk through **Hezekiah's Tunnel** (optional) and visit the **Pool of Siloam** where Jesus sent the blind man to be healed.

Walk the **Pilgrims Tunnel** direct to the Old City.

See the ancient **Southern Steps** and the **Hulda Gates** (II Kings 22:14) which originally led up to the Temple entrance where Jesus is known to have taught and fought with the money changers.

Walk to the **Western Wall**, the holiest site in Judaism and the only visible remains of Herod's splendid Second Temple, where Jesus walked and taught.

Walk through the **Western Wall Tunnel**, huge arched spaces just north of the Western Wall which link to a Hasmonean period (163 to 37 BC) water tunnel.

We conclude our day with a powerful visit to the **Garden Tomb**, held by many Protestants to be the actual location of the burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ (John 19:38 & Luke 23). We will have some time for prayer and meditation and Holy Communion.

Return to the hotel for **dinner** and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 10 – PETRA

(B,D)

You will be picked up from your hotel and transferred to the Allenby Bridge. Cross to Jordan and meet your **Ya'lla Tours** Jordan tour guide.

Drive to **Mt. Nebo**, the traditional burial site of Moses overlooking the Dead Sea and the Jordan Valley. The church is operated by local Franciscan monks and houses magnificent mosaics dating back to the 6th century.

Continue to the holy city of **Madaba**, known for its outstanding Byzantine mosaics. Visit St. George's Cathedral and see the 6th-century mosaic floor depicting the earliest surviving map of the Holy Land.

Continue to Petra for dinner and overnight.

Our hotel in Petra, **OLD VILLAGE RESORT**, is a 4-star DRY hotel built in the style of a local 19th-century village. Guest rooms are comfortably rustic, combining the charm of the past with the modern comforts and facilities of today such as climate control, free Wi-Fi, satellite TV, direct-dial phone, mini-bar and hair dryer. THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 11 – PETRA

(B,D)

Today we will tour the city of **Petra**, the ancient Nabataean capital hidden in the mountains of southern Jordan. Travel part of the way on horseback and the rest on foot through the narrow canyon or Siq. (*As a great deal of walking is included in the visit we suggest good walking shoes and a lightweight jacket*). As you approach the end of the Siq, the Treasury appears magnificently and immediately in front of you, an awesome start to an unforgettable experience. Now we begin our exploration of what both the Nabataeans and Romans left for us to witness. The most adventurous will be invited to hike up to the spiritual "High Place," site of the sacrificial altar with a spectacular view of the ancient city and surroundings.

Return to the hotel for overnight.

Dinner tonight will be at the **Petra Kitchen**, where we learn how to prepare Jordanian food and then we eat what we learned.

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 12 – AMMAN

(B,L,D)

After breakfast, drive to **Wadi Rum** and take a short 4X4 vehicle ride into the oasis, with its awesome lunar landscape. Many films have been shot here, including *Dune*, *The Martian*, and *Lawrence of Arabia*.

Enjoy *lunch* at Wadi Rum.

Drive to **Amman**, Jordan's capital, known as the "White City" because of the white sandstone used in many buildings.

Stop briefly for coffee at a café overlooking the **Temple of Hercules** and the Citadel. Visit the **Roman Theater** of Amman and the Citadel.

Stroll through the old markets in the downtown area and stop to sample some knafeh, a regional treat from the famous **Habibah Sweets**.

Arrive at your hotel for dinner and overnight.

Our hotel, **AMBASSADOR**, is in the heart of the financial district, in one of Amman's quietest neighborhoods, with a breathtaking panoramic view of the city.
